JOB TITLE:

TORQUE WRENCH ASSEMBLER TESTER – TORQUE WRENCH PROCESS

OVERALL PURPOSE OF THE JOB:

To carry out all stages in the production and repair of Norbar torque wrenches to the high standards required by the Company.

KEY TASKS:

- 1. Assemble torque wrenches and sub assemblies to defined procedures using parts available in the vicinity of the workplace.
- 2. Test and adjust each assembled torque wrench using computer based test equipment. Re-adjust until test results are within limits. Issue in-house calibration certificate.
- 3. Laser mark wrenches and other components using jigs and fixtures.
- 4. Pack wrenches in individual containers with certificates and instructions.
- 5. Produce product labels using appropriate equipment.
- 6. Use a range of tools and light machinery situated in the department, including hand tools, power tools and assembly fixtures.
- 7 Identify quality issues and react accordingly. Reject parts which are not up to standard, setting them aside for possible re-work or for scrap.
- 8. Use the company computer systems for recording transactions and finding information.
- 9 Assist with the training of apprentices, young trainees, customers, distributors and new employees.
- 10. Any other tasks as required by Shift Manager Assembly/Cell Leader.
- 11. Responsible for maintaining data accuracy throughout all aspects of the role, reporting all errors using the correct procedure.
