You will also be required to laser mark product and pack wrenches with certificates and instructions for customers.

You will ideally be able to demonstrate previous assembly experience on a production line, where working at speed to meet daily output is required identifying any quality issues with small components or processes. You will be a highly motivated individual who has the ability to work both within a team and on an individual basis.
